

New search policy for home football games

In a continuing effort to provide quality safety and security for Moore Public School's students, staff, and patrons, a new entry search policy will be implemented during home football games beginning September 2nd, 2016.

Throughout the country, similar search protocols have been employed to increase safety for all patrons and we want to provide that same level of safety for fans at our events with large crowds.

All carried items and entrants are subject to search prior to entry. Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's car or discarded. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation, and the person in possession of such items is subject to arrest. Items left at the gate will be discarded. Rejection of this protocol will result in the denial of entry.

The following items will continue to be prohibited:

- Bags, backpacks, fanny packs and hard binocular cases
- Outside Food and Drink
- Alcohol
- Ice Chests
- Large Bags/Large Purses
- Weapons/Pocket Knives/Explosives
- Laser Pointers
- Cigarettes and E-cigarettes

Please understand and anticipate longer lines as we roll out this new protocol. In order to alleviate some of the long lines, we will have an "**Express Gate**" for those students and patrons who pre-purchase their tickets and are not carrying bags. This gate will be located between the north and south ticket booths where the "Pass Gate" was formerly located. The new Pass Gate will be located at the large entry gate by the northwest concession stand.
