Moore High School Student:

Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, all students in public school are required to receive instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) at least once between ninth grade and graduation, as required by the *Dustin Rhodes and Lindsey Steed CPR Training ACT*. This CPR requirement will be posted on your official transcript.

All seniors will watch a CPR video and be required to administer chest compressions on mannequins while being observed by a CPR trained staff member. After successful completion, the students will sign off that they have completed the basic training. Moore High School will train all seniors on **Wednesday, February 13, 2019** beginning promptly at 8:30am. If you are a student that has classes off campus in the morning, then you will be trained on **Wednesday, February 13th at 1:15pm**. Please make every effort to be in attendance on that day as this is a requirement for graduation.
