You can support your child by ensuring they are present for testing, eat a healthy breakfast, arrive to school on time, words of encouragement, review the student practice test, and making sure they have **two #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)**. Any student who arrives after the testing has begun, will not be admitted to class until the test is completed. **Please try to schedule appointments around the test dates.** Thank you for your support and understanding during this important time of the school year.
