

Moore Provides FREE Summer Feeding and Reading Opportunities for Students MPS Summer Food Service Program and Read Moore Book Bus Join Efforts

MOORE, OK – Summertime in Moore Public Schools (MPS) will officially begin when the last school bell rings on Friday, May 24, 2019. Many students are excited to sleep-in a little later, soak up the sun, eat sno-cones and embrace longer days.

However, summer months can also pose challenges for some families and students regarding available meals and continued learning opportunities. MPS is excited to provide free breakfasts and lunches through the Summer Food Service Program and offer elementary and secondary level books and resources through the Read Moore Book Bus.

“Both programs provide essential services for many of our students. Everyone’s circumstances are unique and if we can help relieve stress related to hunger while also making learning material available to our students – whether it is a required summer reading book for a fall course or other – then that is a win/win,” said Superintendent Robert Romines.

Last summer, the food service program provided 5,336 breakfasts and 21,563 lunches. The summer reading program was also successful and served more than 2,000 students and had approximately 10,000 books checked out.

The Summer Food Service Program provides free breakfast and lunch for anyone 18 and under, adult meals are \$3.75. There are many different locations, including cafeterias and parks, where meals will be served throughout the MPS community. Who doesn’t enjoy a picnic in the park!
