During SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT - Dr. Romines:

- Stated that the 2014-2015 accreditation status was received from the State Department of Education. All of our schools were accredited with no deficiencies with the exception of Apple Creek and Sky Ranch Elementary Schools that were accredited with a warning (due to the school report card).
- Reported K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade participating in Title I summer school this past June:
  - Santa Fe Site --130 students on average with the largest attendance at 139 students
  - Fairview Site --90 students on average with the largest attendance at 102
- Congratulated the administration and coaches at **Moore High School** for holding their inaugural "Lion Athletics Kickoff" this week. It was a huge success for the Moore High School community. **Southmoore High School** will be holding their yearly "SaberCat Celebration" football kick off this coming Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 9 a.m. at their football practice facility. **Westmoore High School** will also be holding their yearly "Jaguar Gymboree" football kick off this coming Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 6 p.m. at their football practice facility. Good luck to the Lions, SaberCats, and Jaguars for a safe and successful season!

- Stated the district has finished building the early childhood playgrounds and main playgrounds at Briarwood and Plaza Towers Elementary School thanks to the many volunteers who assisted with the playground builds. He thanked, especially, Kaboom, Nike, Kevin Durant, Nick Whisenhunt, Gametime, and the community of Weslaco, Texas for the funding that made these projects happen.
- Thanked everyone who played a part in the school district being able to rebuild the campuses of Plaza Towers and Briarwood Elementary Schools, the gymnasium at Highland East Jr. High, and the district's Technology Center and Administrative Service Center. Not only was the district successful in rebuilding these sites, we were able to build a new site – South Lake Elementary School. In addition, we continued work on a second new elementary school on the east side of the district, broke ground on the first of four pre-kindergarten centers in the district, and laid the foundation for a sixth junior high. Our district maintenance department was also able to complete a multitude of renovation projects throughout the district and finally, the new junior high stadium renovation is well underway.
- Stated the Administrative Service Center should be completely finished within the next four weeks. The third floor was finished several weeks ago and our Special Services Department has begun to move back in. The offices that were housed on the 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors of the building should be able to move back in before the end of September.
- Reiterated congratulations to our district PTA Council on being named the PTA Council of the Year by the State PTA and congratulated outgoing PTA Council President, Michelle Filipski, on being named the State PTA Volunteer of the Year.
- Stated that “Back to School Night” for all elementary schools will be held this Friday evening, August 15<sup>th</sup>, from 4-6 p.m.
- In closing, he presented a transportation report handout to the board members.
