

Moore Public Schools 7th Grade **Honors Algebra I** Readiness Testing

6th grade students have the choice to take 7th grade Mathematics or Honors Pre-Algebra in 7th grade.

However, there is a third option for the students who excel in Math, have the desire for advanced studies, are self-motivated, and typically score at advanced levels on state tests. 6th grade students can take the MPS Algebra I Readiness Test to see if they can go directly into Honors Algebra I. By scoring a 90% or better on this test and completing a series of summer review math assignments, a student can take Honors Algebra I in 7th grade and are on track to take Honors Geometry in 8th grade. Please be aware, the GPA from Honors Algebra I and Honors Geometry will be calculated into your child's high school graduating GPA.

If your child is attending 6th grade this 2019-2020 school year, you can register your child to take the MPS Honors Algebra I placement test. There are 4 different testing sessions to choose from, all indicated on the registration form. Once a student is registered, parents and guardians will receive a reminder email about 1 week prior to the testing session, with recommended content for student review and details about the session itself.
