#### **Tryout Fee:**

- \$20.00/tryout participant payable on the day of event. For those participants selected for the 2022 Moore Lions Red Dirt Team, the tryout fee will be deducted from the Red Dirt League Fee of \$350/player.
- Red Dirt League Fee will be June 1<sup>st</sup>,2022 payable to Moore Lions Homerun Club. Please contact the Moore Lions Homerun Club if payment arrangements need to made.

# Season:

- Red Dirt season is scheduled from May 31<sup>st</sup> to June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Games are held Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays at various times played and at various school locations both around and outside the city metroplex.
  - Red Dirt players are responsible for their own transportation to and from each game.
  - There will be no scheduled home games during the 2022 Red Dirt Summer league due to the installation of a new all-turf field at the MHS Lions Baseball Complex.

Moore Lions Red Dirt teams will be announced via TeamApp (Moore Lions Baseball) as well as posted near the entrance to the Moore Lions Baseball Fieldhouse.

## Additional Important Moore Lions 2022 Red Dirt Tryout information

- Trying out doesn't guarantee a spot on a Moore Lions Baseball 2022 Red Dirt Team.
- Moore Lions Baseball 2022 Red Dirt Teams will <u>ONLY</u> have 15 players on the roster per team.
- Full baseball attire-pants, shirts, hat, glove, bat, and baseball cleats(spikes)-will be required and expected for all participants. Tryout participants will be responsible for all gear needed for any position in which trying out for.
- Players will be physically tested -please prepare before tryouts.
- Players evaluations will include hitting, pitching, throwing, catching, speed and agility.
- Players are required to provide their own hydration.
- Parents will be allowed in the stands. There will be no admittance to the Moore Lions Baseball Fieldhouse at any point during the tryouts.
