Honors Courses:

- Honors courses are designed to move through curriculum at an accelerated pace and require a heavier load of outside work (homework, projects, reading, etc.). Students who have demonstrated a strong work-ethic AND commitment to academic performance in the past are more likely to be successful.
- Students taking Honors Algebra I or Honors Geometry will receive 1 unit of high school transcript credit but does NOT count towards the 3 math units required to graduate.

Virtual (Online) Classes:

- Full-time (six hours) or part-time (supplemental) online classes are provided virtually through Edgenuity, an online curriculum for students in grades 3-12 used by Moore Virtual Academy. This platform is curriculum delivery only. There is no teacher assigned to assist students with course content. If you are interested in virtual school, please contact your grade counselor.
- All Full-Time MVA students will take elective courses as provided by Edgenuity.
- If a Part-Time Supplemental student is leaving campus during the day, there will not be MPS transportation available. Students will be permitted to ride the bus before or after school. Supplemental students are to arrive 5 minutes before class and leave within 5 minutes after class.
