Electronic Devices

Lab

You must practice lab safety each time we are in the lab. This means you **MUST** be wearing closed toed shoes and wear goggles during the entire lab. If you are wearing open toed shoes on lab day, you will not be allowed to complete lab and will take a zero. If there is a prelab quiz, you must pass it before you are allowed to do the lab.

Tardies

Remember, 2 tardies = 1 absence. You must be seated and ready to begin class when the bell rings. Chemistry is a very challenging class, however with determination and hard work it will also be very rewarding. We only have 50 minutes a day together; you are an essential part of our class and I need you here on time, ready to learn.

Absences

You are responsible for obtaining any notes or completing work you missed while you were absent. You have 1 day for each day absent to turn in any missing work. If you missed a test or quiz, you will be expected to take it the day you return. Please remember you can always find out what you missed by going to the calendar on my school website.
