#### **Alternative Programs**

MAST - Moore Alternative School and Treatment grades 7-12 for students who are experiencing behavior, legal, and or substance abuse related problems. This program is a partnership between MPS and Moore Youth and Family Services.

VISTA Academy - Designed for "at-risk" students who have not been successful in the regular school setting.

Night School- Designed for the "at-risk" student who has not been successful in the regular school setting, the student who needs evening class time, and/or a student who has dropped out of school and wants to return to pursue graduation requirements.

Canvas - Canvas is the Learning Management System used by PreK-12th grade teachers and students. It serves as a platform where teachers can post assignments, create discussion boards, and upload content like PowerPoints and instructional videos.
