# Title I Program

- Title 1 is a federally funded program allowing students experiencing academic difficulty to receive extra help and individual attention with no cost to the parents.
- Schoolwide program - literacy coach model, meaning students are not “pulled out” for separate instruction; rather, students and teachers are provided tiered (leveled) supports.



# Schoolwide means:

- WJH uses Federal Title I funding to upgrade the entire educational program of the school.
- Title I funds are used to serve all students in order to raise academic achievement.
- Title I funds provide the school with: A certified Literacy Coach; hands-on learning materials & supplies, software to enhance learning opportunities; a tutoring program, parent involvement activities, and professional development opportunities for Teachers.





# Who receives Title 1 Support?

- All students within the school benefit from our RiseUP Program - Reading/Math resources, after-school tutoring, student conferencing, co-taught lessons, parent involvement activities, etc...
- All students within the school are given multiple reading and math assessments throughout the school year. These test results help identify students needing additional resources and intervention supports.

STAR Reading and Big Ideas Math

State Testing (OSTP) in April of each school year

- Any parent may sign up to enroll their student in our after-school tutoring program.
- Teacher recommendations




# RiseUP - What Title I Does...

- Identify students most in need of educational help (specifically in Reading, LA, and Math)
- Set goals for individual and schoolwide improvement
- Measure student progress
- Develop programs to support classroom instruction
- Involve parents in all aspects of the program
