Begin at the corner of S.E. 82nd Street and S. Walker Ave., go east to Sooner Road, go south to S.E. 119th Street, go west to Santa Fe Ave., go north to S.W. 104th Street, go west to S. Walker Ave., go north to S.E. 82nd Street.

SCHOOL BOARD CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

- The individual must have resided within the school district for at least six months and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of Board Seat #3 for six months.
- The individual cannot have been convicted of, or have pled guilty or no contest to, a felony under state or federal law or a misdemeanor involving embezzlement. Any person having a record of any of these crimes is ineligible to file for the school board position during the pending of any appeal or for a period of 15 years following completion of a sentence.
- The individual must have been awarded a high school diploma or certificate of high school equivalency in order to be a candidate for or elected to serve on a board of education.
- The individual must not be related within the second degree by blood or marriage to a current school district employee or a current member of the board of education. Second degree relatives are: Spouse; Child or Child's Spouse; Parent or Parent's Spouse ;Grandchild or Grandchild's Spouse; Grandparent or Grandparent's Spouse; Sibling or Sibling's Spouse; Spouse's Child or Spouse's Parent; Spouse's Grandchild or Spouse's Grandparent; Spouse's Sibling; Siblings of "half-blood," meaning that two individuals share one parent, are considered equal to a full sibling sharing two parents.

BY SIGNING THIS FORM, THE APPLICATION IS AFFIRMING THAT HE/SHE MEETS ALL THE ABOVE QUALIFICATIONS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR APPOINTMENT TO SCHOOL BOARD OFFICE #3 OF MOORE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.
