Complete On-Line Registration (OLR)

- Must Have Active PARENT PORTAL ACCOUNT
- Access to OLR begins 2-16-2021
- **Deadline is 3-12-2021**

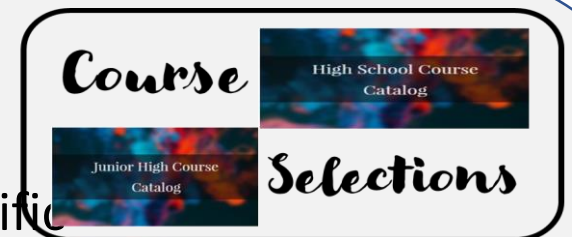

- Follow links on enrollment page to register returning students
- To register for the first time (new students) you will need to upload several documents. Use the Enrollment Page link to access a list of these documents. All of these should be saved on your computer as PDF files to make the process faster and more convenient.

Complete Course Selection Process

- Must Complete On-Line Registration
- Students will receive course selection forms from counselors. Specific instructions will be shared with students.
- Please know that this year you will have to make a choice for one of the following:
 1. **In-Person Learning (Student attends school all day, in-person, in the school building)**
 2. **Full time Virtual Learning (Student attends through Moore Virtual Academy with all on-line courses)**
 3. **A combination of In-Person and Virtual Learning through Supplemental On-line courses and In-Person courses**
 4. **Concurrent Enrollment: College courses that count as dual credit for graduation (11th and 12th grade only, approval required)**
 5. **Moore/Norman Technology Center: (11th and 12th grade only, approval required)**



Note: For Concurrent Enrollment courses and Moore/Norman courses where approval is required, flexibility will be given to the 3-12-2021 deadline. If students do not meet requirements and then cannot enter those programs, counselors will work with students/parents to select appropriate course alternatives. However, once selections are finalized (prior to the end of this school year) changes will not be possible next year.

Additional Important Information

- **DEADLINE INFORMATION** – Once you have made your course selection from the five options above for next year (deadline 3-12-2021) that decision cannot be changed. Please consider options carefully. **If the process is not completed by the deadline, students will automatically be enrolled for In-Person Learning as a permanent selection (full year).** Extenuating circumstances involving a catastrophic medical problem may be considered with documentation from a licensed professional in that field. Contact your Principal for specific details.
- **CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT** - Concurrent Classes are those offered through a local college or university. These courses can be selected by juniors and seniors and can also be a Supplemental selection so that students attend In-Person Learning as well as Concurrent Classes. Students must meet ACT or grade point average requirements. These vary by college or university. If students change their minds about taking Concurrent Classes after enrollment is finalized, then they may only be able to take an On-Line Supplemental Course to replace the Concurrent Course.
