

2020 Summer School Distance Learning INFORMATION AND STUDENT BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

SUMMER SCHOOL IS AN EXTENDED OPPORTUNITY FOR STUDENTS TO LEARN AND ACHIEVE SUCCESS. STUDENT SUCCESS WILL BE DEPENDENT UPON A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT BETWEEN STUDENTS, PARENTS, TEACHERS AND THE ADMINISTRATION, ESPECIALLY DURING THIS TIME OF DISTANCE LEARNING.

1. **ABSENCES:** All distance learning will be done from home this summer. If you are in a math class, you are expected to be in the zoom feature when the teacher opens the meeting up. Your teacher will give you further information on this. It is VITAL your teacher have correct phone numbers so you may be reached if there is an issue with your course. If you are in an online math class, your teacher will be monitoring your progress. This means you will have to be online during the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 1:00 p.m. M-F Odysseyware displays your progress and your time logged in to the program. Those who are taking a class other than math can find details on the General Information page.
2. **DISCIPLINE:** Mrs. Clark will deal with all Odysseyware performance issues. If you are not working in your course, you will be disabled on Odysseyware. It is important that you remember the purpose of your time in distance learning. If you are enrolled in a Zoom course (math), you must make sure all comments, behavior and countenance are appropriate for the Zoom discussion. This includes dress code appropriateness. If the teacher removes you from the Zoom, you will not be allowed to complete the course for the summer. It is the equivalent of a suspension from school and removal.
3. All Moore Public Schools rules and policies as are written in the MPS Secondary Education Handbook apply to Summer School, both Junior High and High School.
4. **THERE ARE NO TUITION REFUNDS GIVEN AFTER THE FIRST 3 DAYS OF CLASSES, BOTH SESSIONS, FOR ANY REASON.**
5. **Food:** Remember that the food fest is still offered during the summer. This means you are welcome to go to the chosen sites and get breakfast and lunch. The times for this are 11:00-1:00. Talk to Mrs. Clark or Mr. Brown if you have questions.
6. **Bad Weather:** In the event we have inclement weather such as lightening, good practice would be to turn your device off until the lightening /storm is subsided.
