

# 2021 Summer School

## INFORMATION AND STUDENT BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

1. **ABSENCES: On-site students:** There will be **NO** make-up days/hours for excessive absences. Once a student has exceeded 10 hours of absences, they will not pass the course. One day absent is equal to 4.5 hours absent. Two tardies is equal to one hour absent. Students who are one to ten minutes late at the beginning of school or when returning from break will be counted tardy. Students arriving more than 10 minutes late will be counted absent for an hour. **Tuition will not be refunded for failure of a class due to excessive absences and or tardies.**

**Virtual students:** It is your responsibility to login and complete all course work before July 2<sup>nd</sup> or **you will receive an F in the course and you will NOT receive a refund.** It is VITAL you provide correct phone numbers, so you may be reached if there is an issue with your course.

2. **DISCIPLINE:** There will be **NO** detentions for behavior problems. Students will conference with the summer school principal, Mrs. Clyma, for the first offence. Any further rule infraction(s) including but not limited to classroom disruptions, defiance of authority, etc., may result in a time-out period for the remainder of the day. **Hours accrued during a time-out period will be counted as absences.** The summer school administrator will attempt to call parent/guardians to inform them of the discipline problem. **Additional or severe disciplinary infractions may result in the student being dismissed for the remainder of the summer school session. Tuition will not be refunded for disciplinary actions of this nature and any grades or credit earned in the class will be lost.**
3. All Moore Public Schools rules and policies as written in the MPS Secondary Education Handbook apply to summer school, both junior high and high school.
4. **School transportation is NOT provided.** All students must have transportation available to pick them up from summer school **no later than 1:15pm** each day.
5. **THERE ARE NO TUITION REFUNDS GIVEN AFTER JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup> FOR ANY REASON.**
6. Summer school is a **CLOSED CAMPUS.** Students may not leave campus during school hours, including breaks and lunch. The parking lot is off limits during school hours. **There are no exceptions.**
7. Students who wish to carry a cell phone must comply with district policy. Students are **NOT** to use cell phones during class time. Cell phones must be put away during class time and must not be a distraction. Violation of this policy may result in confiscation of the device and other disciplinary actions. Confiscated devices may be retrieved after the school day has ended.
8. **Severe Weather: In the event a severe weather warning is issued during summer school hours the district Tornado Sheltering Plan will be initiated.**
  - Once students are in school, if a severe weather watch or warning is issued, parents have the option of picking up/checking out their child and receiving an excused absence. If someone other than the parent/guardian is checking out a student, make sure that your child's school has the correct non-parent emergency contact information on file.
  - If it becomes necessary to shelter in place, for the safety of all involved, no student will be allowed to be checked out.
